Our Honorees



Beverly Bavly is a champion of collaboration and partnership, bringing fresh thinking, energy, and creativity to her leadership at Hebrew College. She believes that Jewish education is core to the continuity and vitality of the Jewish people, and she works tirelessly to strengthen Jewish learning and leadership—

at Hebrew College and beyond. A consummate connector, Beverly serves as an ambassador in the community for Hebrew College and other organizations where she serves on leadership boards, including Boston Jewish Film, the Touro Synagogue Foundation in Newport, R.I., and AMIT Children. A proud parent and grandparent, Beverly worked in fine jewelry sales at Joseph Gann Jewelers in Boston, founded by her father, before retiring to volunteer. She remains inspired by her parents' legacy of *tzedakah*.



Nancy Kaplan Belsky has been passionate about and devoted to Jewish communal service for the past 40 years. She served as chair of CJP's task force that increased services and programs for people with disabilities, including those living with mental illness. She also worked closely with JF&CS to develop

the CHAI residential and Employment Services programs. When her mother was diagnosed with Alzheimer's, her focus broadened to advancing programs for seniors, especially those living with memory illness. She has also been a fervent supporter of Jewish Big Brothers Big Sisters of Boston's "Friend 2 Friend" and LGBTQ+ programs. Nancy got involved in Hebrew College through "Torah Babes," an adult learning study group that now learns with Hebrew College President Rabbi Sharon Cohen Anisfeld. Through this group, Nancy learned about Hebrew College's compelling mission and transformative adult learning experiences and was inspired to invest in Hebrew College's innovative vision. Her family foundation is committed to an exciting collaboration between Hebrew College and 2Life Communities, which grants internships for Hebrew College rabbinical students to do pastoral work at the 2Life Community campuses. Nancy serves as Vice President of the Rita J. and Stanley H. Kaplan Family Foundation. She is past Board Chair of the Jewish Community Centers of Greater Boston (JCCGB) and has served on the boards of Combined Jewish Philanthropies of Greater Boston, The Institute of Jewish Spirituality, and The Rashi School. Nancy, her husband, Mark R. Belsky, MD, and their two standard poodles, spend most of their time in Lenox, MA. Besides Jewish communal service, their numerous hobbies include biking and hiking. They have three children and three grandchildren.



Susan Schechter has been engaged in Jewish studies at Hebrew College since 1998 with a group of women, fondly known as the "Torah Babes," an adult learning group at Hebrew College. She is also a recent alum of The Institute for Jewish Spirituality's Kivvun program. Susan retired in 2000, following a successful career in marketing, sales, and financial communications, and has since been involved in educational, health and cultural organizations. She serves on the Foundation Board of Boston Arts Academy and is an overseer at MSPCA Angell. Previously, she served as a Trustee at Mass College of Art and chaired the Mass College of Art Foundation Board. She has been a long-term supporter and co-chaired annual fund philanthropic events for The Grow Clinic at Boston Medical Center, the Mass Art Auction, and the MSPCA Angell gala. Susan and her husband, Bob, have been members of Temple Beth Elohim in Wellesley, Mass. for over 20 years. They have two grown sons, both living in Brooklyn, and enjoy traveling, hanging out with friends, and counting their blessings.



Myra Snyder is passionate about building Jewish community, supporting Jewish education, and championing the mission and vision of Hebrew College. She is a 1997 graduate of Me'ah Classic, Hebrew College's two-year, 100-hour community education program. She went on to earn a Masters of Judaic Studies from Hebrew College in 2001, the same year that

Hebrew College moved from Brookline to Newton Center. After graduating, Myra went from student to volunteer extraordinaire, serving on the Hebrew College Advisory Council and later on the Board of Trustees. Myra and her husband, Robert, are founding members of B'nai Torah in Sudbury, Mass.; Temple Shir Tikva in Wayland, Mass.; and MetroWest Jewish Day School in Framingham, Mass., where she has also served as president of the boards. She has been active in the Boston Jewish Film Festival, BOLLI: the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute at Brandeis University, and the northeast branch of University of Haifa and CJP (Lion of Judah). Myra graduated from the Forsyth School for Dental Hygienists at Tufts University and worked as a Registered Dental Hygienist, mostly in pediatrics with special needs children. She received her B.S. degree at Northeastern University.



Diane Troderman has spent the last 30 years devoted to the renaissance and renewal of Jewish life. She is passionate about Jewish education, culture, and values, and is committed to Hebrew College's future as a center for Jewish learning and leadership that emphasizes culture and collaboration. Diane was the founding chair of the Hadassah

Brandeis Institute, where she continues to serve on the board, helping to inspire fresh ways of thinking about Jews and gender worldwide. She also serves on the boards of Israel Sci-Tech; Hebrew Publics: A Hebrew Charter School Network; the William Davidson Graduate School of Jewish Education at the Jewish Theological Seminary; the Washington Institute for Near East Policy; and Shalom Learning. Together with her husband, Harold Grinspoon, Diane has been instrumental in the growth of the Harold Grinspoon Foundation. She serves as a trustee and focuses on PJ Library, which sends children free, award-winning books that celebrate Jewish values and culture. In addition to education, Diane is also dedicated to women's issues and to the renaissance and renewal of Jewish life in the former Soviet Union. Between them, Diane and Harold have six children and eleven grandchildren.




